**ORDER**

On Petition to Review an Order of Dismissal

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 357 and Rule 18 of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, the complainant has filed a petition for review of an order entered by the Acting Chief Judge on April 1, 2014, dismissing the complainant’s complaints of judicial misconduct pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii) & (iii) and Rule 11(c)(1)(B) & (D) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.

The petition for review was considered by the Judicial Council of the Sixth Circuit\* pursuant to Rule 19 of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, at a meeting of the Council held on May 12, 2015. All eligible members of the council who were present having voted for affirmance of the dismissal of the complaints, the order of dismissal will be affirmed.
