**ORDER**

On Petition to Review an Order of Dismissal

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 357 and Rule 18 of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, the complainant filed a petition for review of an order entered by the Chief Judge on October 16, 2014, dismissing the complainant’s complaint of judicial misconduct pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii) and Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.

The petition for review was considered by the Judicial Council of the Sixth Circuit pursuant to Rule 19 of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. After the complainant filed his petition for review, the district judge who is the subject of this complaint passed away. Because the subject judge is now deceased, the judicial complaint process is nugatory as against him. Due to this intervening event, the complainant’s petition for review will be denied as moot.

It is therefore ORDERED that the petition for review is DENIED as moot.
