**ORDER**

On Petition to Review an Order of Dismissal

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 357 and Rule 18 of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, the complainant has filed a petition for review of an order entered by the Chief Judge on August 1, 2014, dismissing the complainant's complaint of judicial misconduct pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii) and Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.

The petition for review was considered by the Judicial Council of the Sixth Circuit\* pursuant to Rule 19 of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, at a meeting of the Council held on May 12, 2015.
