MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

This complaint of judicial misconduct was filed by **[REDACTED]** (“complainant”) against the Honorable **[REDACTED]** (“subject judge”), pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 351. The complaint refers to a civil action in which the complainant sued the subject judge, among other defendants, but it does not set forth any allegations of judicial misconduct.

Since the filing of this complaint, the subject judge has died. The complaint must therefore be concluded under Rule 11(e), Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. In any event, the complaint would be subject to dismissal under Rule 11(c)(1)(D) because it does not allege any misconduct. See *also* 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the complaint be concluded pursuant to Rule 11(e) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.
