**MEMORANDUM AND ORDER**

This complaint of judicial misconduct was filed by [REDACTED] (“complainant”) against the Honorable [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (“subject judge”), pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 351. The complainant generally asserts the subject judge made improper rulings in an underlying criminal case.

Since the filing of this complaint, the subject judge has died. As such, the complaint must therefore be concluded under Rule 11(e), Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, which permits the chief judge to conclude a complaint in light of such intervening events.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the complaint be concluded pursuant to Rule 11(e) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.
